Sustainability at Amilla

Studies show that 87% of travelers want to travel sustainably. People around the world to focus more than ever on wellness and boosting their immunity. Sustainability at Amilla is not a catch word, it is not sales term, it is not a face we show to the world.

We have integrated these factors into the fabric of the guest experience at Amilla. We have devised innovative sustainability and wellness initiatives to entice guests, whilst simultaneously positively impacting the lives of our team members, too. These projects in turn help enhance our local environment and community.

This includes things like reusable bamboo straws, compostable pot scrubbers, reusable containers to reduce plastic wrap and compostable room slippers.

These changes as well as energy, water and waste reductions at Amilla have also now been recognised with Silver level certification by EarthCheck.

This is an external recognition of the internal changes and work the Amilla islanders have achieved over the past two years.



The Nut

Amilla has an abundance of coconut trees on the island. Buying coconut milk and fuel for the barge used to remove the waste products was costly so we created The Nut, a dedicated coconut processing facility located on the isaland.

We utilise the coconuts and byproducts as much as possible to make items such as:

- Cold-pressed virgin coconut oil.
- Coconut water (which can also be used in making kombucha, kefir and 'Kaijan' roofing (thatch). coconut vinegar).
- 'Mudi kaashi' (Coconut sprouts; the inside of baby coconut).
- Coconut milk, cream and yoghurt.

- Products for Javvu Spa
- Coir rope.
- Coco peat for the gardens.

This initiative has reduced Amilla's coconut waste by approximately 80% and helps lower our carbon footprint.



Homegrown@Amilla

Our Homegrown@Amilla project goes hand in hand with Homemade@Amilla, which focuses on utilizing the huge range of natural resources we have on our uniquely fertile island.

- Mystique Garden Our garden, which guests can visit and dine in, produces herbs and vegetables including superfoods that are used in our kitchens.
- Sweet Spot Dedicated to growing sweet potatoes. Each 'spot' produces up to 15kg of this delicious healthy starch.
- The Plantation Producing delicious organic bananas, pumpkins and papayas.
- The Pentagon Our mushroom hut. We grow white oyster mushrooms in organic matter.
- Cluckingham Palace Home of the happiest chickens in the Maldives. These hens gobble up our kitchen waste and provide us with fresh eggs.
- Hydro Garden This area has 18 hydroponic gardens. They are a water and energy-efficient way to grow lettuces and other greens.
- Microgreens station They are grown adjacent to the main kitchen so chefs can pick them as needed, bursting with freshness.

Ocean Bound Plastic Programme

One way that we are working to mitigate environmental impact on a more global scale is in the use of ocean bound plastic materials. We are converting as many fabric items as we can to eco-fabric.

Made from plastic waste collected from beside river ways in India, this material assists in reducing waste in a number of different ways. It reduces waste going into landfills but more importantly it reduces waste entering into the oceans. This avoids the waste dropping micro plastics into the ocean.

We have converted many items into this material including hairdryer and laundry bags in villas and beach bags that we give our guests upon arrival. We have even made bags for covering plates for food delivery rather than using plastic wrap.

The arrival bags for children has also been converted and is now in the shape of the endangered bird that lives on our island, the White Tailed Tropic Bird.
